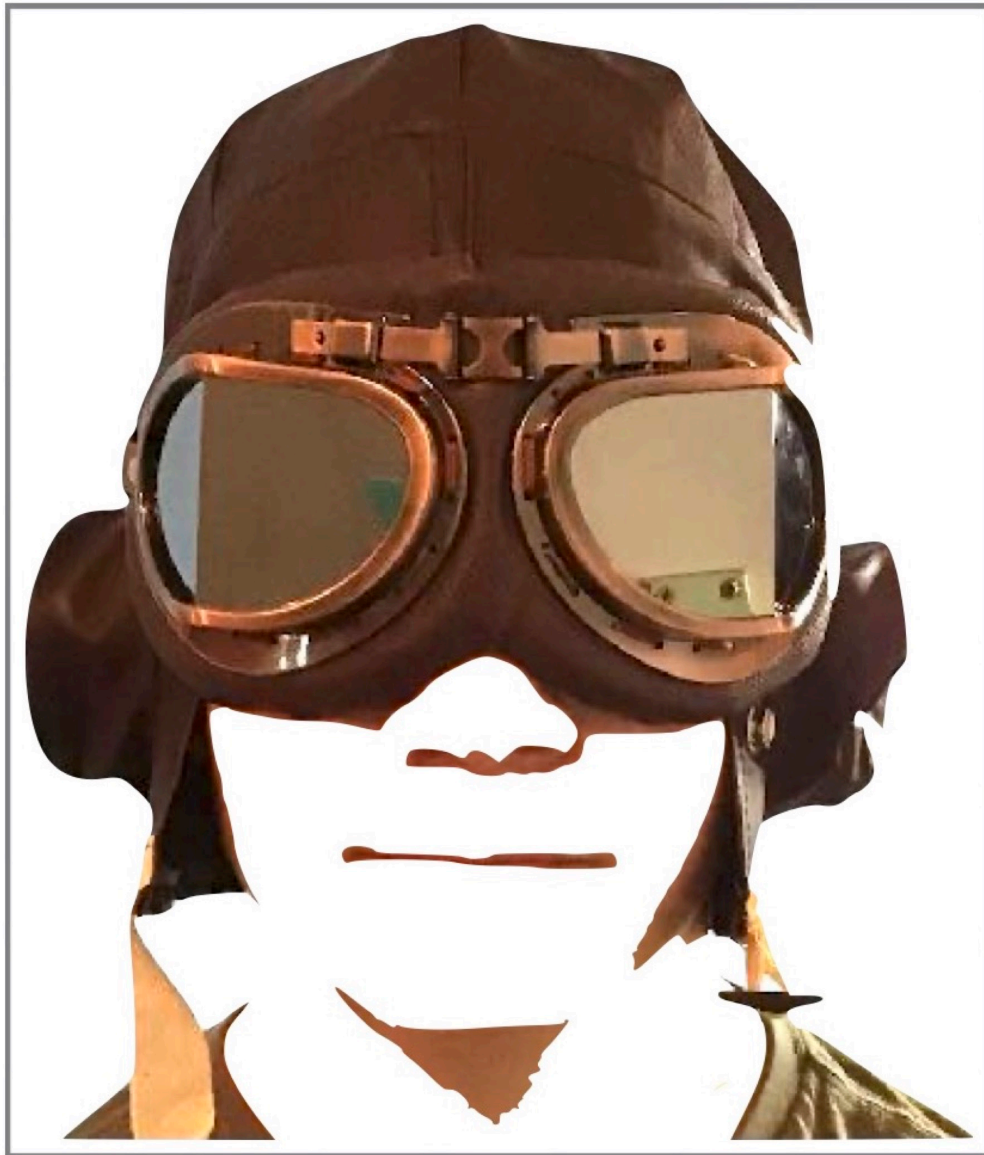

Flying Helmet Mask

Not suitable for young children who may put pieces in their mouth

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General Suggestions

Two people should build together one should be an adult

Read through information before starting

Cut out all shapes you will need before starting to glue

Glue in a well ventilated place

Take time to let glue set properly before next stage

Use kitchen roll sheet to press glued shape onto card

Using cereal boxes, glue shapes onto printed side

Do not print pages double sided

Masks should be kept away from water

Please recycle offcut paper/cardboard

No plastic in model

Your pilot mask

You will need

1. Scissors (to cut out pilot helmet shapes)
2. Tube of glue
3. Shirring elastic
4. Card (see note bottom of page)

Making

1. Cut out the pilot mask shape and make goggles holes using red guide lines as shown
2. Make tiny holes to feed elastic through in yellow circles
3. Cut 60cm length of shirring elastic
4. Put end of elastic through each hole from the back
5. Tie double knot at the front
6. Lay elastic on back of mask
7. Cut out ear phone covers and glue over front at elastic
8. Make knot in elastic at the back to suit head size

If using thin paper to print, suggest you glue mask to card then cut out

Alternatively you can use a thicker 170 gsm paper
