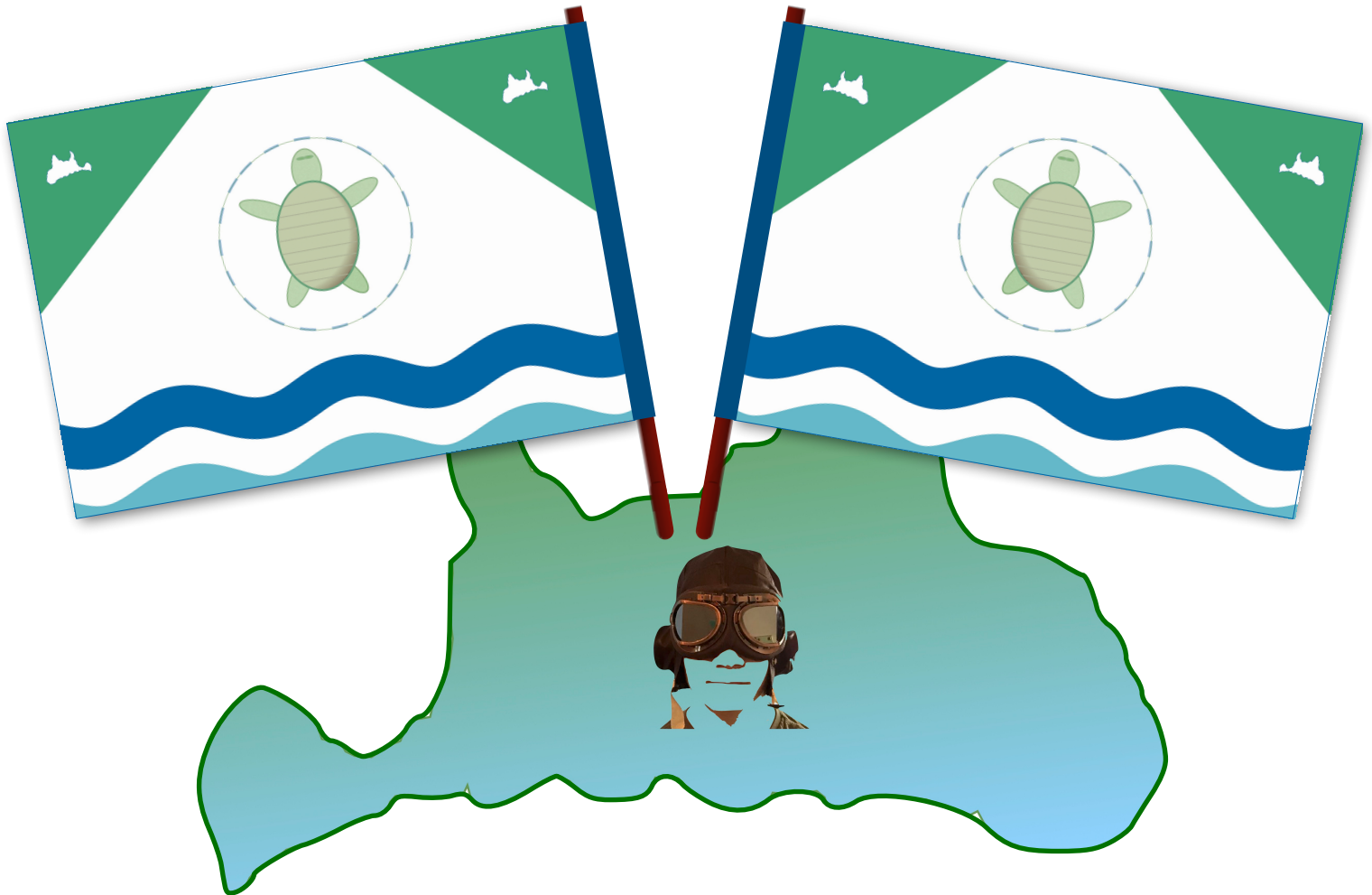


Ayden's Adventures



Hukata Island Flag

Not suitable for young children who may put pieces in their mouth

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General Suggestions

Read through information before starting

Cut out all shapes you will need before starting to glue

Glue in a well ventilated place

Take time to let glue set properly before next stage

Use kitchen roll sheet to press glued shape onto card

Using small cereal boxes, glue shapes onto printed side

Models should be kept away from water

Please recycle offcut paper/cardboard

No plastic included in this model

Spare/repair parts included

Hukata flag

You will need

1. Scissors (to cut out flag shapes)
2. Tube of glue
3. A small stick (lollipop or similar)

Making

1. Cut out the flag rectangle as one piece and exactly line up fold to make two sides of a flag
2. Cut out the rectangle with the blue strip
3. Add glue to the blank side
4. Wrap around stick so that the blue area is seen round the flagpole and close over
5. On the blank side of the flag shape apply glue over one half and a strip to the other half (see photo)
6. Close fold overlapping on white part sticking out from the flagpole
7. Firmly press closed and wait for glue to dry

(You have now made your flag)
